THEIR UNDERGRADUATE / MASTER'S EDUCATION ABROAD

Candidates who possess the documents specified in the announcement are required to submit their applications to the Master's and Doctoral programs via the link below between 16 December 2025 at 15:00 and 11 January 2026 at 23:59.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR FINAL REGISTRATION

1- International candidates, as well as candidates who are citizens of the Republic of Türkiye and who have completed their undergraduate or master's education abroad, may apply under the international quotas.

2- Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate: For programs conducted in Turkish, candidates are required to obtain a minimum C1-level Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate within two semesters from TÖMER (Turkish and Foreign Languages Application and Research Center), DEDAM (Dokuz Eylül University Language Education Application and Research Center), or the Yunus Emre Institute.

3- Foreign Language Proficiency Certificate: Pursuant to Article 17, Paragraph 6 of Dokuz Eylül University Graduate Education and Training Regulations, admission to doctoral programs requires a minimum score of 55 from centrally administered foreign language examinations recognized by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK), or an equivalent score from internationally recognized foreign language examinations accepted as equivalent. According to Article 5, Paragraph 6(a) of the same regulation, applicants to master's programs are required to obtain a minimum score of 55 from the foreign language proficiency examination administered by the School of Foreign Languages, or at least 50 from centrally administered foreign language examinations recognized by YÖK, or an equivalent score from internationally recognized foreign language examinations accepted as equivalent. Regarding the validity of foreign language certificates, scores obtained from examinations administered by ÖSYM are valid for five years as of the date of registration. For other examinations whose equivalency is recognized by ÖSYM, foreign language certificates obtained within the last three years are considered valid.

4- ALES, GRE, or GMAT Score Certificate:

For master's program applications: Applicants are required to have obtained a minimum score of 55 from the ALES examination, in the relevant score type of the applied program, within the last five years.

For doctoral program applications: Applicants are required to have obtained a minimum score of 60 from the ALES examination, in the relevant score type of the applied program, within the last five years.

Note: For applicants who have graduated from doctoral programs, proficiency in art programs, medical specialization, dental specialization, veterinary specialization, or pharmacy specialization, the ALES requirement is waived for applications to master's programs. For the purpose of evaluation, regardless of the score type used for admission to the previous graduate program or the field of specialization, the ALES score of these applicants shall be considered as 70. During the online application process, applicants must enter 70 in the ALES Score field. For such applications, the relevant graduation certificate must be declared at the time of registration.

5- Diploma: For master's program applications, a bachelor's degree diploma is required; for doctoral program applications, both bachelor's and master's degree diplomas are required.

6- Certificate of Institutional Recognition: This document must be obtained from the Council of Higher Education (YÖK).

Citizens of the Republic of Türkiye who apply under this quota may also submit their application with a Certificate of Institutional Recognition. However, they are required to submit the Diploma Equivalency Certificate to the Institute by the time of graduation.

7- Transcript: For master's program applications, a bachelor's degree transcript is required; for doctoral program applications, both bachelor's and master's degree transcripts are required.

8- Tuition Fee: For international students and Turkish citizens who have completed their undergraduate education abroad, the tuition fee for the 2025/2026 Academic Year is 51,000 TRY, and it is subject to annual revision.

10- Photocopy of Residence Permit.

11- All documents must be translated into English or Turkish.

The responsibility for any missing documents or incorrect statements lies with the applicant. In such cases, the registration shall be cancelled.

EVALUATION OF APPLICANTS:

All documents submitted by the applicants at the time of registration will be reviewed by the relevant Departments and evaluated on a 100-point scale. In order to be eligible for registration, master's program applicants must obtain a minimum score of 65, while doctoral program applicants must obtain a minimum score of 70. Applicants will be ranked within the announced quotas, and those who are entitled to registration will be announced accordingly.

VETERINARY PATHOLOGY	Veterinary Pathology	Turkish	1	Applicants are required to hold a bachelor's degree diploma certifying graduation from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Faculty of Fisheries, Faculty of Nursing, or the Departments of Biology or Molecular Biology and Genetics within Faculties of Science, or, in the case of Turkish citizens who have completed undergraduate degree programs of the aforementioned faculties at foreign universities, to possess an equivalency certificate issued by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK).
